Lead-Safe Practices for Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP)

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has enacted new regulations affecting contractors performing renovation work in residential dwellings or child-occupied facilities built before 1978. This regulation is called "Lead: Renovation, Repair and Painting Program" (RRP). Beginning in April 2010, any renovation work (including painting) which disturbs painted surfaces in residential dwellings or child-occupied facilities built before 1978, must be performed by persons trained in lead-safe work practices, with specific responsibilities for a new discipline of "**CERTIFIED RENOVATOR.**" To become a Certified Renovator, a person must attend an 8-hour EPA-approved training course from an accredited training provider.
